These workshops provide insight into the testing process and will include a skill demonstration of the frequently missed skill steps and frequently identified issues observed by the testers. We will discuss the changes made to the candidate handbook. We will also go over the availability of WebETesting.



Most Commonly Missed Skill Steps

Listed below are the most commonly missed steps of each of the 9 skill tasks. The % shows the number of students who performed the step correctly.

Nasal Administration Spray/ Tablet Administration

12. Closes MAR	78%
19. Have resident blow nose	67%
Ear drops/ Tablet Administration	
18. Lowers head of the bed	69%
19. Shakes Polysporin before use	19%
20. Head is turned toward right	75%
Eye Drops/ Tablet Administration	
23. Instructs resident to blink eye	75%
Liquid/ Ointment Administration	
13. Closes MAR	70%
Oral Capsule Administration	
14. Close's MAR	75%
Oral Tablet/ Eye Drop Administration	
19. Close's MAR	78%

10. Closes MAR	74%
Spray Skin/ Tablet Administration	
22. Instructs resident to turn face away from spray	67%
Oral Liquid/ Ear Drop Administration	
2. Candidate obtains correct medication	69%
4. Verbalizes right drugs	69%
6. Medications selected are for the right time	69%
19. Lowers head of the bed	69%
24. Tells resident to not move their head for a few minutes	75%
30. Candidate uses hand sanitizer	75%



Ohio CMA Testing

First, go to hdmaster.com, click on Ohio CMA, then On-line Training Reports.



You have a choice of four training reports to choose from. You can individualize your reports by time frames. Fill in the four simple fields below to produce the report that suits your needs. In step 3, your ID is the 4 digit number provided by D&S and your PIN is a 6 digit letter that must be entered in all caps.
