To continue to be an approved test site, the test site must have all of the materials necessary to properly administer any of the randomly selected skill tasks. The RN Test Observer is required to review all of the skill tests they receive, prior to administration, to ensure that the appropriate skill testing equipment and supplies are available prior to testing.

RN Test Observers: Use this checklist immediately upon arrival at the test site. Report any missing or inoperable items, along with any other testing anomalies, in the irregularities section of TMU for this test event prior to submitting the test event for scoring. Call us before cancelling the test event if the missing equipment makes it impossible to adjust, in some fashion, to hold the test event. Sometimes we can help with creative solutions to 'adjust' the test event so it might still be able to continue. Adjustments to 'normal' test event protocols should only be done in a live consultation with D&SDT-HEADMASTER staff.
