# RN Test Observer or Test Site Equipment List and Affidavit Form 1503NV

(TEST SITES: this form MUST be accompanied by form 1502NV. A virtual test site visit will be arranged with D&SDT-HEADMASTER) (RN TEST OBSERVERS: this form must be accompanied by forms 1500NV, 1501NV and 1505NV)

The testing site must include all of the materials necessary to properly administer any of the randomly selected skill tests. The RN observer is required to review all of the skill tests assigned to the test candidates prior to administration and ensure that the appropriate laboratory equipment is available prior to testing. Please refer to the following list for equipment requirements.

# **EQUIPMENT/SUPPLIES PROVIDED BY TESTING SITE**

- At least three internet-connected computers with the capacity to play .WAV files to administer oral exams.
- Internet-connected computer, laptop or tablet in Skill Test area and/or internet access for RN Test Observer provided laptop or tablet
- Hand washing sink with hot and cold running water, liquid soap, and paper towels (must be no further than 30 second walk from skills lab and within the distraction and interruption free skill task area)
- Long term care bed with working bed brakes and bed controls (Beds that automatically lock when raised [legs stay down] or have alarm sounds when locked are not acceptable - brakes must require manual engagement in order to lock)
- Manikin (anatomically correct perineal area for female)
- Working privacy curtain(s) (may not be portable screen)
- Bedside stand
- Overbed table.
- Wheelchair with working brakes and removable footrests
- Toilet or Commode (if toilet is not available in skills lab)
- Food tray & disposable spoons.
- Teaching (bi-aural) stethoscope with two different sized BP cuffs
- Pulse oximeter (non-verbal does not announce oxvgen reading)
- Electronic blood pressure monitor with cuff (non-verbal - does not announce BP reading, wrist types are not acceptable)
- Digital oral thermometer with thermometer sheathes.
- Dentures (one plate, upper or lower, only for testing), denture container and denture cleanser
- Water pitcher and glass
- Bed pans 1 Standard and 1 Fracture Pan
- Urinary Drainage Bag with catheter and tubing

- Additional catheter with tubing.
- Output measurement container/graduate
- Wash basins
- Emesis basin
- Gait belts/transfer belts
- Linens including: pillows (4), pillowcases, flat and fitted sheets, bath blankets, towels, wash cloths, water proof pads, blanket, resident's gowns
- Laundry receptacle (hamper)
- Wastebasket
- Isolation Gowns (must have ties, no Velcro or snaps)
- Disposable Gloves in assorted sizes
- Tissue/Toilet Paper
- Alcohol or alcohol pads
- Hand sanitizer

# ROOM REQUIREMENTS

- Distraction Free Skills Lab with wall clock for administration of skills exam (with all equipment and supplies listed available and in good working order)
- Distraction Free Knowledge Test Room with wall **clock** – for administration of the Knowledge Exam
- Holding or Waiting Area where candidates may wait to take the exam
- Any signage (posters) or displays in skill/knowledge test rooms that may cue candidates on skill performance or knowledge test questions and answers must be covered or removed on test days
- If the skills lab and/or knowledge test room have any interior windows (i.e. - on the door), they would need to be covered (blinds/etc.) during testing.

Due to test security, cameras in the skills lab or knowledge test room are prohibited!

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# ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT PROVIDED BY THE RN TEST OBSERVER

- RN Test Observer may provide own laptop or tablet for Skill testing
- Actor's toothbrush, toothpaste and paper cup
- Official data recording forms post it pads provided by Headmaster
- Small clipboard on which to place the recording form
- Pens/pencils for documenting recordings
- Three audible count-down timers (2 for the skills testing and one for the knowledge testing)
- Non-skid socks for Actor
- Lotion for Foot Care
- Oversized button shirt/blouse, sweat pants, and socks that will easily fit over actor's clothing
- Sample food items (single serve size container of applesauce, pudding etc.)
- Diet Card and napkins

 1 Clear 240 cc glass for Feeding Skill (a bendable straw is recommended to use with this skill)

- ORAL TEST ADMINISTRATION: Disposable headphones/ear buds to plug into the computer speaker jacks
- Pre-measured "urine" fluid amounts in unmarked containers (hint: use yellow food coloring in water for bedpan and output and urinary drainage bag tasks)
- Watch with a second hand

## RECOMMENDED ADDITIONAL ITEMS TO CARRY IN TESTING KIT

- Wash cloths and towels that you know are clean to be used during the Abbreviated Bed Bath task on your actor
- A syringe to easily fill the drainage bag with premeasured fake 'urine'
- Extra audible count-down timers in case a set doesn't work or batteries are dead
- Other small items you can use as backups to salvage a test event when something breaks or is missing etc.
- Back up hand sanitizer
