EQUIPMENT LIST PRE-TEST INVENTORY MANDATORY CHECKLIST – FORM 1504NV

Please refer to the following list of equipment and supplies required to ensure all needed equipment and supplies are available when you first arrive at the test site for your test event. To continue to be an approved test site, the test site must have all the materials necessary to properly administer any of the randomly selected skill tasks. The RN Test Observer is required to review all of the skill tests they receive prior to administration to ensure that the appropriate skill testing equipment and supplies are available prior to testing.

EQUIPMENT/SUPPLIES PROVIDED BY TESTING SITE

At least three internet-connected computers with the capacity to play .WAV files to administer oral exams.

Internet-connected computer, laptop or tablet in Skill Test area and/or internet access for RN Test Observer provided laptop or tablet Hand washing sink with hot and cold running water, liquid soap, & paper towels (*must be no further than 30 second walk from skills lab and within the distraction & interruption free skill task area*) Long term care bed with working bed brakes and bed controls (*Beds that automatically lock when raised [legs stay down] or have alarm sounds when locked are not acceptable – brakes must require manual engagement in order to lock*)

Manikin (anatomically correct – perineal area for female) Working privacy curtain(s) (may not be portable screen) Bedside stand

Overbed table.

Wheelchair with working brakes and removable footrests

Toilet or Commode (if toilet is not available in skills lab)

Food tray & disposable spoons.

Teaching – (bi-aural) stethoscope with two different sized BP cuffs Pulse oximeter (non-verbal – does not announce oxygen reading) Electronic blood pressure monitor with cuff (non-verbal – does not announce BP reading, wrist types are not acceptable)

Digital oral thermometer with thermometer sheathes.

Dentures (one plate, upper or lower, only for testing), denture container and denture cleanser

Water pitcher and glass

Bed pans – 1 Standard and 1 Fracture Pan

Urinary Drainage Bag with catheter and tubing

Additional catheter with tubing.

Output measurement container/graduate

Wash basins

Emesis basin

Gait belts/transfer belts

Linens including: pillows (4), pillowcases, flat and fitted sheets, bath blankets, towels, wash cloths, water proof pads, blanket, resident's gowns

Laundry receptacle (hamper)

Wastebasket

Isolation Gowns (must have ties, no Velcro or snaps)

Disposable Gloves – in assorted sizes Tissue/Toilet Paper Alcohol or alcohol pads Hand sanitizer

ROOM REQUIREMENTS

Distraction Free Skills Lab with wall clock - for administration of skills exam (with all equipment & supplies listed available & in good working order)

Distraction Free Knowledge Test Room with wall clock – for administration of the Knowledge Exam

Holding or Waiting Area – where candidates may wait to take the exam

Any signage (posters) or displays in skill/knowledge test rooms that may cue candidates on skill performance or knowledge test questions and answers must be covered or removed on test days

If the skills lab and/or knowledge test room have any interior windows (i.e. – on the door), they would need to be covered (blinds/etc.) during testing.

Due to test security, cameras in the skills lab or knowledge test room are prohibited!

RECOMMENDED ADDITIONAL ITEMS TO CARRY IN TESTING KIT

Wash cloths and towels that you know are clean to be used during the Abbreviated Bed Bath task on your actor

A syringe to easily fill the drainage bag with pre-measured fake 'urine'

Extra audible count-down timers in case a set doesn't work or batteries are dead

Other small items you can use as backups to salvage a test event when something breaks or is missing etc.

Back up hand sanitizer

RN Test Observers: Use this checklist immediately upon arrival at the test site. Report any missing or inoperable items along with any other testing anomalies in the irregularities section of WebETest© for this test event prior to submitting the test event for scoring. Call us before cancelling the test event if the missing/inoperable equipment makes it impossible to accommodate testing. Sometimes we can help with creative solutions to "adjust" the test event so it might still be able to continue. Adjustments to "normal" test event protocols should only be done in a live consultation with D&SDT-HEADMASTER staff.
