Virtual transcription testing: Points to remember

- All candidates will test in this online format. A candidate with an approved ADA
 detailing the need for written testing can be permitted to test with a paper
 transcription test.
- All candidates will have the ability to self schedule into a transcription test event.
 (If there is an approved ADA specifying written testing, then an onsite test proctor from their facility must be present for testing like before.)
- The new virtual transcription testing will involve group testing. A Zoom link will be sent to the candidate the day before or the morning of testing by the test observer.
- o Each candidate will be required to have two devices available for testing.
- A candidate CAN NOT use a Smartphone device to log into TMU and take the
 test. They can use the Smartphone device to connect to the Zoom video link, but
 the candidate MUST log into TMU with a desktop or personal computer that has a
 functioning mouse or touch pad.
- Google Chrome must be used for testing. Do NOT use Internet Explorer. Do NOT use Safari.
